What's Going On?

As most IAPA members know we had an absolutely fantastic meeting last October on the LVI campus in Las Vegas. If you missed it, since we learn from history, you will want to make sure you never miss another one – including this year's.

Just to let you know, the IAPA website is getting a new format and will be changed soon. This has been a long work in progress and a lot of tweaking, (not to be confused with tweeting), and testing. You will find it easier to navigate and find useful information. One new feature will be the blog space so new information can be disseminated to the IAPA membership quicker than our usual newsletter. The blog will be for any information useful for you as a dentist and especially as a physiological neuromuscular dentist. Thus, there may be clinical, research, academic, legislative, and oppositional information involved.

Brief updates in our world of dentistry which may still have an effect on physiological neuromuscular dentistry are:

1. A victory in Texas for the American Board of Dental Specialties. The ABDS is a specialty certifying board independent of the ADA. The result of the suit means the state board cannot prevent non-ADA certified specialties from advertising themselves as specialists. As of now those specialties under ABDS are American Board of Oral Implantology/Implant Dentistry, American Board of Oral Medicine, American Board of Orofacial Pain, and the American Dental Board of Anesthesiology. There are talks of some TMD groups also becoming a specialty under the ABDS. This victory in Texas follows similar victories in Florida and California. The IAPA board is following this and considering its ramifications for our IAPA members.

- 2. There are still problems for PNM dentists in Quebec, Canada. The authorities have written laws limiting the practice of NMD. Many NM dentists are fearful of practicing dentistry as it may cost them their license. NM dentists in other provinces are afraid these "guidelines" may be adopted by their own province. IAPA has contacted the authorities in Quebec but with without any positive result.
- 3. The BioPsychoSocial philosophy groups are trying to ramp up their attacks on PNM. This again is constantly being monitored by the IAPA board. If a more direct attack happens again, as it did in 2006 and 2007, the board will once again notify our members and call for action. In case you are not aware, as a direct result of our actions in 2006, there were changes made through the ADA.
- 4. The IAPA has participated in the American Alliance of TMD Organizations for many years. This organization is comprised of diverse TMD organizations which have the commonality of an occlusal philosophy concerning TMD. There are many issues which concern the organizations regarding freedom to practice an appropriate philosophy of treatment. The group meets physically once a year during the Chicago Dental Society Midwinter Meeting in Chicago. Once again this year the IAPA had representatives at the meeting. The main interest this year was on specialization. (See #1 above)
- 5. Recent interest in Sleep disorders, Myofunctional Therapy, and importance of proper breathing, or Oxygen Therapy, in regards to more successful TMD treatment has spurred the improvement and addition of courses at LVI on Myofunctional Therapy and Oxygen Therapy course.
- 6. Bill & Heidi are traveling around the country giving two day courses on PNM and to add to that, Ashely Johnson and Bill Wade are on the road to the same places Bill & Heidi are going to offer K7 training! For those lucky dentists in those towns, that's almost like having them give you an in-office training for a whole lot less money! (Special rate if you take both.)

Needless to say, the IAPA and LVI are not just sitting around - things are happening. If you do not follow the forum daily, (only takes 5 minutes), consider checking in on our IAPA blog as often as you can. Hopefully you will find it is a real value to your PNM/ Sleep practice.
